Mystic Ballet to present Love Stories

NORTH STONINGTON – On Valentine’s Day at the Foxwoods Casino/Mashantucket Pequot Auditorium, Mystic Ballet will present “Love Stories.”

Three enticing, diverse tales of love; the sophisticated “Sonata”, primal “Rite of Spring” and poignant “Death and the Maiden” will be followed by a “Meet the Artists” post performance talk and question/answer period with Artistic Director Desiree Subotic, Resident Choreographer Sergei Vanaev, and Mystic Ballet dancers.

Mystic Ballet’s “Dynamic Directions” is a compilation of edgy, neo classical, contemporary works for young adults and older audiences. Most of the works, created by its resident choreographer Sergei Vanaev, are world premiers, or they are being

performed for the first time to American audiences.

For this season, Mystic Ballet has expanded its company to nine professional dancers from the U.S. and abroad, Brazil, Japan, Mongolia and Germany. This is a Pay What You Wish Production. Mystic Ballet is a nonprofit organization, and depends on ticket revenue.

Patrons can purchase tickets online for a suggested price or one of three PAY-WHATYOU-WISH amounts. Tickets at different PAY-WHATYOU- WISH amounts can be obtained (subject to availability) for either performance at the door.
